- ☀️ You will notice on some days a book is in your child's folder. Once we have worked on a book in a reading group I send the book home for another practice. Please listen to your child read and offer support when necessary. These books need to be returned to school the next day unless they are paper books for your child to keep.
- ☀️ Math homework is coming back at about a 75% rate. Please sit down with your child and help him/her do homework each night it is sent home (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday). Establish a specific time so your child knows what is expected. Please check his/her work for accuracy and make sure their name is at the top. No name, often means no credit for the work.
- ☀️ I have many children coming to school without a snack. First grade students do not eat until 12:40 each day. Snack is necessary to keep your child fueled.
- ☀️ We are going on a field trip on Thursday, October 6th. Please dress your child for an outdoor field trip. Thank you to the 3 parents who volunteered to go with us and the many others who I don't need this time but will call upon another time 😊
- ☀️ Friday, October 7th, there is no school for the children. Teachers have a workshop day.
- ☀️ Monday, October 10th is Columbus Day. There is no school.
